PLEASE REPLENISH ALL SUPPLIES at the end of each quarter.

**If your child will be bringing a backpack to school please be sure it fits in the locker.

**If your child wears glasses, be sure he/she has them at school.

ALL ITEMS BROUGHT TO SCHOOL SHOULD BE PERMANENTLY LABELED WITH THE STUDENT'S NAME.

The school will supply a combination lock for hallway lockers (use is optional). A fee of \$8.00 is charged for these locks and will be kept throughout their time in middle school. As students finish 8th grade, they will have the option to return the lock and have their fee refunded. A combination lock for gym lockers is supplied at no charge. The replacement cost for lost gym locks is \$8.00. Students are not allowed to use combination locks from home. Due to school safety concerns, personal locks not issued by the school will be cut off.

Students are encouraged to reuse as many items as possible from the previous year to keep costs down.

When selecting back-to-school clothing, please consider school guidelines on what is appropriate. No sleeveless shirts or tank tops, no questionable T-shirt imprints, no excessively short, tight, or torn clothing are allowed. Consult the school handbook or ask the principal if clarification is needed.
